Church Profile

Located in one of the most beautiful parts of God's creation - in Manitoba's Whiteshell Provincial Park - All People's Church ministers to about 200 congregants in summer and about 20 in winter. Members and congregants of the church are year-round residents of Falcon Lake and area, cottage owners who spend weekends and summers at the lake, and campers and visitors to the park. A few of the church's full memberships are held by community residents, but at this time most of the current members are associates who have taken up memberships in All People's Church in addition to their memberships in their home or winter churches.

The church is housed in a beautiful building, dedicated in 1993, that is well-constructed and appointed for worship services, children's ministries, congregational and community events, and small group meetings. The mission of All People's Church, as articulated in the church constitution, is to promote the Good News of Jesus Christ in the town of Falcon Lake, in the Province of Manitoba, in the country of Canada and throughout the world, in accordance with the Great Commission of Jesus. Denominationally, the church is affiliated with the Evangelical Free Church of Canada.

The heart of the church is centered both on the draw to worship together as believers and on the desire to be a light in the community. Sunday worship services, a stellar guest music ministry, weekly children's church, a week-long summer day camp, and congregational/community meals and barbecues are some of the outward signs of the church's love and sense of purpose.

Senior Pastor Job Description

All People's Church is seeking a Senior Pastor with these qualifications:

- is strongly motivated and able to preach and teach the truth of God's Word
- has pastoral ministry experience
- is in agreement with the constitution of All People's Church
- holds to the Statement of Faith of the Evangelical Free Church of Canada and its denominational requirements
- has a heart for the local community as well as the local church

The responsibilities of the Senior Pastor will be to:

- teach/preach weekly from May to October (some variation in this schedule is negotiable)
- encourage membership in All People's Church
- present an overall plan of ministry to the church board and congregation
- oversee and organize, in conjunction with the Church Board, the preaching ministry, administration of the Lord's Supper, baptisms, musical programming, guest speakers, community outreach, children's church and a one week children's day camp ministry
- become acquainted with the residents in the local community and in surrounding areas (residence in the town is not required although the church provides a small seasonal home for the Pastor's use)
- plan and organize, in conjunction with the Church Board, bi-weekly Bible Studies for the winter church community
- be available, as the Lead Elder and Spiritual Shepherd, to address the personal needs of church members throughout the year
- participate as a member of the Church Board, and attend Church Board meetings throughout the year
- be accountable to the Church Board and present a ministry report to the membership and congregants at an Annual General Meeting
- attend and participate in EEFC denominational gatherings

Remuneration:

The salary of the Senior Pastor will be established by taking into consideration education, experience and the responsibilities which are negotiated with the Board.
